

TRAK4 Quickstart Guide

1. **Charge your Trak4** (two hours initial charge recommended).
2. **Sign up for your free account:**
 - a. Go to GPS.Trak-4.com and enter email and password.
 - b. Check your email to verify your account.
3. **Assign Trak4 to your account:**
 - a. Log into GPS.Trak-4.com.
 - b. Add asset: Create a name for your asset and enter your Trak4 Key Code.
 - c. Choose a subscription.
 - d. You may want to change the reporting frequency (battery life will depend on frequency of reports).
4. **Install Trak4:**
 - a. Install the device on your asset (inside or outside).
 - i. Use zip ties, screws, double-sided tape, rivets, or even duct tape.
 - ii. Or simply place the device inside a pocket or compartment.
5. **Enjoy Tracking!**

Trak-4 Battery Life

- Your Trak4 comes with a rechargeable battery that can provide up to 18 months of tracking on a single charge with daily GPS reports.
- Your battery life will depend on how quickly GPS information can be acquired. Place your Trak4 somewhat “open to the sky” for best results.
- When no GPS signal is found (for example, inside a metal building), Trak4 will use cell trilateration to give you a general location (often within ½ mile). Cell trilateration is only approximate and will decrease battery life.
- It is easy to set up a low battery alert to remind you to charge your Trak4.
- You may choose to connect your Trak4 to a continual trickle charge. This can be done using a typical cell phone charger with a micro-usb connector.

Use this guideline to what battery life you can generally expect:

| Reporting Frequency | Battery Life |
|---------------------|--------------|
| Daily | 12-18 months |
| Hourly | 2-4 months |
| 15-minute | 2-4 weeks |
| 2-minute | 2-4 days |

Trak-4 Weatherproof Covers

Your Trak4 comes with high-quality adhesive PVC hole covers made with ultra-bond adhesive. Use these to cover the charging port when your Trak4 is exposed to the weather.
